Area 1 Horizon Overview

For customers using Microsoft Office 365, doing a POV with Area 1 for detecting phishing emails is quick and easy to set up as detailed below.


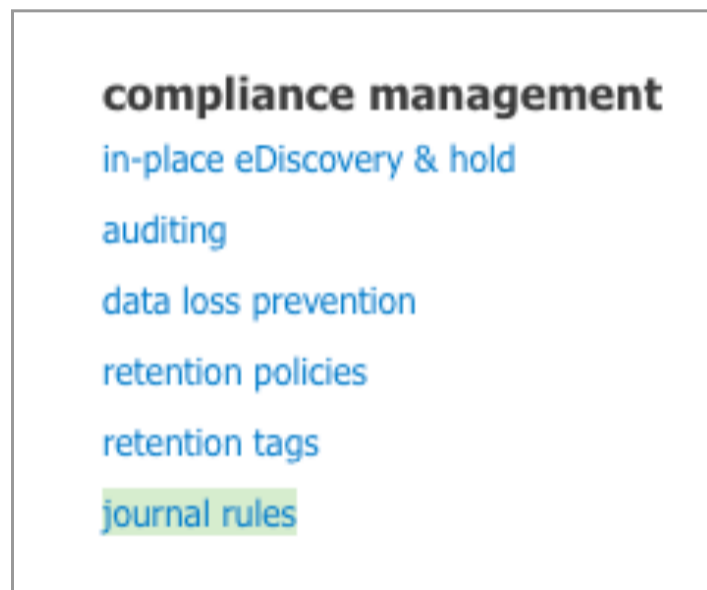
Email Flow During POV



Configuration Steps:

- 1) Load your Office Exchange admin center dashboard
- 2) Select "journal rules"
- 3) Select the Plus Icon to create a new rule

- 4) In the “Send journal reports to:” section add in the Area 1 journaling address that was sent to you in a welcome email or which can be found here:

- 5) Optional: give your rule a name
- 6) For full coverage and scanning, select “Apply to all messages” for “If the message is sent to or received from...” We recommend including all messages to provide full coverage of phish detection from both external and internal origins.
- 7) For full coverage and scanning, select “All messages” for “Journal the following messages...”. We recommend including all messages to give coverage of phish scanning throughout your entire organization.
- 8) Select “Save” to activate your new rule
